Double major students not only have to fulfill all graduation credit requirements of their original major (department or degree program), they must also complete all core courses for the second major (department or degree program) in order to be granted a double major degree.

Undergraduate students who did not complete or are short of **50** credits for the second major must make up for those credits by taking courses designated by the second-major department or degree program.

X. Students who graduate from the study period of the senior high school less than 6 years will be required to take <u>at least 12 extra credits</u> in their graduation requirements.
